BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared Deputy Frank Ashton #8327 who after being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says that he or she has good reason to believe and does believe and charge that heretofore, on or about the 5th day of March A.D. 2018, and before the making and filing of this complaint, in the County of Wilson, and the State of Texas, one Robert Mikell Ussery, hereafter "Defendant", did then and there, intentionally and knowingly remain on property of another, when Defendant had notice to depart, to-wit, remained on the property of 216 4th Street, Sutherland Springs, Texas at the First Baptist Church property, when Defendant had notice to depart. On Monday, March 5, 2018 at approximately 11:46AM, Pastor Frank Pomeroy was on the church property and got into a verbal dispute with Robert Mikell Ussery and Jodie Marie Mann who were also on the grounds of the church. Pomeroy told Ussery and Mann to leave the property which they continued to verbally shout profanities towards Pomeroy and refusing to depart. Constable Fowler made the location and made contact with Pomeroy. Constable Fowler notified the dispatcher over the radio that they were actively trespassing at that time he arrived refusing to leave. I arrived on scene where Constable Fowler and Deputy Dennis had both Ussery and Mann detained. As I exited my patrol unit at the location, I could see and hear Robert Ussery being belligerent with the officers who detained him. I approached Ussery and advised him he was under arrest and began to place handcuffs on his wrists as he began to pull away and started cussing and pulling away from my grasp on his arms. I advised Ussery to stop resisting as I used force necessary to gain control of his other arm to place the hand cuff on.
