

ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant's oral request for reconsideration of detention, which the District Court referred to the undersigned for consideration on June 2, 2022. A hearing was held on that date, and the Court ordered the U.S. Pretrial Office to prepare an addendum to the pretrial services report. The Court received the addendum on June 8, 2022.

Title 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f) provides that a detention hearing may be reopened "if the judicial officer finds that information exists that was not known to the movant at the time of the hearing and that has a material bearing on the issue whether there are conditions of release that will reasonably assure the appearance of such person as required and the safety of any other person and the community." After careful consideration of the arguments at the hearing and the addendum to the pretrial services report, the Court does not find that new information exists that would have a material bearing on the issue of release.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the oral request for reconsideration of detention is **DENIED**.
